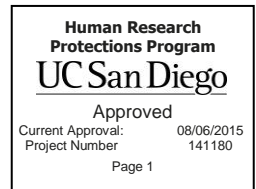


Research Study at the UC San Diego CARE Program



- **Have you or someone you know experienced recent troublesome changes in behavior or strange new emotions?**
 - **Do you have trouble thinking clearly or concentrating?**
 - **Have you been mistaking noises for voices?**
 - **Do you have unusual or overly intense new ideas?**
 - **Are you suspicious of or uneasy with others?**
- and**
- **Between 14 and 30 years of age**

If you answered “yes” you may be eligible to participate in a research study that is being conducted by Kristin Cadenhead, M.D. in the Department of Psychiatry to find out more about the effects of therapy on functioning.

Participation in the research study lasts 12 months and involves the following:

- In depth interview to evaluate recent changes in thoughts, behavior and emotions.
- Assignment to one of two therapy groups that meet for 1 ½ hours per week for 18 weeks.
- Complete follow up assessments at week 18 and 12 months.

Participants will be paid \$50 for the baseline assessment, \$25 for the 18 week assessment, and \$50 for the 12 month assessment. You will receive \$15 per visit to cover the cost of transportation.
